Classes: Limited 1-dog, 2-dog, 4-dog & 6-dog classes.

Judging Times: Saturday 16 May – Check in by 2.00 pm: Heat 1 commences at 3:00 pm (weather permitting)
Sunday 17 May - Check in by 7.30 am*: Heat 2 commences at 8:00 am, (weather permitting)
* earlier start may be required for 4 & 6-dog teams or in warmer weather conditions

Bib Numbers: Will be available for collection prior to the commencement of the event at check in.

Event location: Simpson Track between Campaspe Road and Barry Track. Enter and exit the event site from the Huntly-Fosterville Road, Barry Track, Fosterville (-36.689430, 144.467319)

ANKC Titles*: This event will be a qualifying event for the ANKC Working Team Dog and Working Lead Dog titles conducted under the Dogs Australia Sled Sports rules (updated 2025):

Awards: 1st, 2nd & 3rd in each class. First Alaskan Malamute Team

Eligibility: Restricted to ANKC registered dogs (Main, Limited, Sporting, Associate) twelve months of age and over. See Appendix A of the ANKC Sled Sports rules for breed specific eligibility
All drivers must be members of an ANKC member body and a minimum of 16 years of age.
If this is the driver's first sled dog race event, they must enter in the 1-dog class. Proof of race experience must be provided if you have not raced with the club before.

Equipment: Lighting: Suitable battery-operated bike lighting is required by teams in all classes.
The additional use of a head lamp is also recommended. Note: Dynamo powered lighting is not suitable. Full equipment requirements can be found in the Sled Sports Rules – Chapter 2, Section 2.

Weather policy: Weather policy is in accordance with the ANKC Sled Sports Rules and Dogs Victoria extreme weather policy. In addition, please note that times may be altered or events may be cancelled in severe or unsuitable weather conditions. The event may also be cancelled if severe weather conditions are predicted for the event area.
